A WORD FROM DEBBIE:

May you feel God's love this Christmas! There are many words commonly used on Christmas cards, and in familiar carols that we get used to hearing over the years... peace, joy, goodwill, even hope. Their very presence in the air instils confidence and a good feeling in the hearts of families and those who participate in the celebrations we love to hold in this Christmas season. It is wonderful to know that there is at least one special time in the year when we all make a special effort to spread love and joy to others. The birth of Jesus is still being celebrated more than 2000 years after the actual event, and inspired by this seemingly insignificant historical event, whose immeasurable effects reach into eternity, we are a people united in joy and in the common purpose of giving to others, materially, and through the friendship we offer those around us at this time of the year. A special collection is always taken up at Christmas time in our parish,

and through that collection we try to support special causes that are close to our parish's heart. As we have mentioned at recent Masses, our special collection this Christmas will directly help Fr Jason's work in Meru Kenya. Fr Jason's community is extremely grateful for the contributions we have already been able to send to them through Rotary International, including funds raised through the Milking Cow project, supported by Milkshake days at our school, the Angels of Kenya project, and through the generosity of our parishioners over a long period of time now. Teachers have been paid their wages, and there are children who are able to attend school now who could have lost that opportunity due to poverty, just two of the achievements that our fundraising has facilitated. Fr Jason has given us details of some of the projects that he is currently working on, especially building a new toilet block at the school during the holiday break, complete with hygienic handwashing facilities, and he is busy organising

structural maintenance of the classrooms. The excited, happy faces we have seen by video, of children who live in joy despite hardship, encourage us to help those who can't help themselves. As we enjoy the peace and happiness of being together with those we love this Christmas, we pray for all who do not have the classic 'happy family' life that the Christmas cards tend to depict, especially all of those around our world who are affected by poverty, injustice, violence and fear. May their stories, and the example of the Holy Family who became refugees fleeing to keep their newborn son safe, encourage us to treasure the time we have with our own families, overlooking the challenges, and building on the positives of the love we share.
